



FREE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND RECOVERY SUPPORT

Critical Impact

Since 2017, the Catholic Charities statewide network has been the leading provider of **critical** disaster recovery and preparedness services statewide. Our programs ensure California's **most vulnerable** populations receive the support they need.

- **400,000** disaster recovery services provided to **60,000** Californians impacted by disasters.
- **1.7 million** Californians engaged through emergency preparedness outreach.
- Services provided in **54 of 58** counties statewide.

Programs

- **Disaster Case Management Program (DCMP)** – Free recovery services for Californians impacted by federally declared disasters: support with Insurance, SBA, and FEMA Appeals; repair and rebuild support; advocacy; and linkage to other appropriate community resources.
- **LISTOS California** – Free emergency preparedness education and outreach to boost awareness and resilience; services inform diverse communities and connect them to culturally responsive resources for an array of emergencies.
- **Federal Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP)**– CCC leads the CA-EFSP State Set-Aside Committee to allocate set-aside funds to high-need local jurisdictions across California to help with feeding, sheltering, and rental/utility assistance only.
