



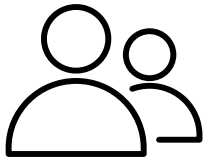

CCC’s NUTRITION SERVICES

Catholic Charities of California is the **only statewide nonprofit network delivering coordinated CalFresh Healthy Living and CalFresh Outreach services** through trusted, community-based organizations.

Since 2018, CCC has helped over 430,000 families access and maintain food benefits, has provided 15,000 nutrition education classes, and implemented 7,000 projects to improve community health.

WHAT’S AT RISK



The elimination of SNAP–Ed funding and reduction in SNAP Outreach funding at the federal level is straining the CCC network now — cutting staffing, outreach capacity, and nutrition programming across the 12 agencies statewide.

LOSS OF TRUSTED OUTREACH INFRASTRUCTURE

Infrastructure that cannot be quickly rebuilt

ELIMINATION OF NUTRITION PROGRAMMING

Increases hunger and poor health in California’s most vulnerable communities

FEWER ENROLLMENT ASSISTANCE SERVICES

CalFresh recipients more likely to lose benefits even when still eligible

INCREASED BARRIERS FOR VULNERABLE FAMILIES

Struggling households face impossible choices—e.g. pay the rent or put food on the table?
